

Terms and Conditions

The following cancellation terms apply:

Early Bird tickets:

- All tickets can be canceled up to and including *February 12, 2025*.
- After February 12, 2025, all tickets are transferable up to and including *March 28, 2025.*

Standard tickets:

- All tickets can be canceled up to and including *March* 19, 2025.
- After February 12, 2025, all tickets are transferable up to and including *March 28, 2025.*

All tickets are invoiced after the cancellation period has expired.

Ticket upgrades from one day to two is possible with the initial price until March 19, 2025. All tickets are transferable up to and including *March 28, 2025*. All changes must be sent in writing and must be sent to <u>info@theiia.se</u> for approval by IIA Sweden.

All ticket cancellations must be in writing and must be sent to info@theiia.se for approval by IIA Sweden.

Incurred expenses

The IIA Sweden is not responsible for any incurred expenses such as, but not limited to, airline tickets, hotel costs, other tickets or payments, or any related or associated costs, fees, penalties, losses or expenses registrants may incur or have incurred as a result of any trip cancellations or changes. Force Majeure

IIA Sweden will not be responsible for any loss, damage, injury, claims or expenses of any kind whatsoever if the event is cancelled, postponed or altered due to a Force Majeure. Force Majeure is defined as any unforeseen occurrence that renders performance of the event impossible, inadvisable, illegal or impracticable. Force Majeure includes, but are not limited to: casualty, fire, explosion, flood, earthquake or other natural disasters, governmental restrictions or regulations, war or apparent acts of war, terrorism or apparent acts of terrorism, civil disturbances or riots, strikes, curtailment, suspension or restriction on transportation facilities and means of transportation or any other emergency.
